Weimar University's RN to BSN program

1. Is a candidate for ACEN Nursing Accreditation.
2. Emphasizes health promotion and disease prevention for the whole person (body, mind, spirit).
3. Provides students with opportunities to precept in an area of interest.
4. Produces graduates who are sought by employers because of their unique education in health promotion.
5. Encourages bi-vocational options.
6. Prepares students for further education leading to advanced practice nursing and nursing education.

9. Is offered only three days per week to accommodate students' work as RNs during the program.



The RN to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN) Program may be completed in 12 months after licensure. This Nursing program consists of opportunities for mission nursing, community nursing, and preceptorship in an area of interest. All required General Education classes are offered at Weimar and may be taken during the RN to BS Nursing Program.

Since August 2017, Weimar University's weekly service program called Total Community Involvement (TCI) has gotten attention. Even peer reviewers from an accrediting team have especially recognized TCI and its impact.
